

Educational Director

The Educational Director works as part of the workshop team to help create a positive musical theater experience for youth by engaging their imagination and fostering a life-long relationship to theatre through outstanding educational and artistic programming. This position requires an individual who possesses strong communication and leadership skills and an ability to collaborate with others. A fundamental working knowledge of the basic areas of theatre art (acting, directing, design, voice, etc.) and a strong passion for theatre are assets. Experience working with young people and having a positive attitude are required. Must be flexible and willing to assist with other production duties as needed. Educational and stage experience preferred.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Attend all production meetings
- Work closely with the Artistic Director to ensure educational material and program development compliment the production
- Educate children in the field of theater by implementing age appropriate games and organized activities which provide a safe, inclusive and creative environment for learning
- Teach an appreciation of and respect for the various roles/aspects inherent within the theatrical process.
- Teach theatre skills that help develop voices, bodies and imaginations
- Create a weekly newsletter
